Pastor's Message



Dear Friends:

One of the special things about being a pastor with a Catholic grade school is that you often get many homemade birthday cards. The one from a 2nd-grader that made me laugh simply said, "I like you as a priest. I wish you could turn younger so you could be our priest for longer." That is when I realized that I am no "spring chicken" and am probably the age of the grandparents of most of the 2nd-graders!

I give thanks to God for the gift of my priesthood, knowing that in some mysterious way Christ called me to this life from a young age. I always thought this calling came to my conscious awareness during my senior year of high school, but then a few years ago one of my grade school teachers, Sr. Suzanne Clark, told me that it happened much earlier. She said that when I was in second grade, I went up to her one day on the playground and told her that someday I was going to be a priest. I have no recollection of that moment at all.

Despite all that has gone on in the Church and the priesthood these past few decades, I have no regrets about the path I have chosen. It is hard to believe that this past April 6 I celebrated 30 years of priesthood. I have had so many graced experiences celebrating the sacraments for people, especially baptisms, weddings, confessions, and funerals. I have spent my priesthood in parishes, in Campus Ministry, in seminary work, and overseas in our East Africa mission. Above all, it has been about serving God's amazing people—especially people like you—who are the face of Christ for me.

It takes a lot more courage to say "yes" to God's call to be a priest today. Young men will not find the same level of encouragement that I did back in 1981 when I first entered the seminary. Still, we need zealous and holy priests now more than ever. Fortunately young men are still answering God's call, thanks especially to their parents who have encouraged them.

Please join with me in thanking God for these four Holy Cross deacons who were ordained priests yesterday at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart at Notre Dame: Fr. Felipe Campos, C.S.C., from Laredo, Texas; Fr. Robert Lisowski, C.S.C., from Old Forge, Pennsylvania; Fr. Geoffrey Mooney, C.S.C., from New Albany, Indiana; and Fr. David Smith, C.S.C., from Wantage, New Jersey. What a gift they are to the Congregation of Holy Cross. May they have many years of joyful and fulfilling service as Holy Cross priests!

In addition, this means that someday Fr. Michael and I can actually retire, though I would like to think that there is still a lot of tread left on the tires for both of us.
