

# **HOLY REDEEMER'S SVDP CONFERENCE**

"Giving help and hope one person at a time." The Society of St. Vincent de Paul was founded by a small group of students in Paris in 1835 and now stretches across the globe. Its namesake and patron saint was a sixteenth century priest from Pouy, France who became known as the "Father of the Poor." The Society was unique for its time in that it was formed by lay Catholics, and it offered

charity to foreigners as well as non-Catholics. A truly Christian enterprise! Our conference at Holy Redeemer seeks to reflect this Vincentian spirit through our rent and utility assistance program as well as a food pantry, all staffed and funded entirely through volunteers. Our pantry receives food from the parish as well as partner agencies such as the Oregon Food Bank, Safeway, and Nite Hawk Cafe & Lounge. Each conference is governed by a Board of Directors which includes a spiritual advisor and is overseen by the Portland District Council <a href="https://www.svdppdx.org">www.svdppdx.org</a>. Meetings take place in the rectory on the **second Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m**. # Fr. Michael's Message





Dear People of Holy Redeemer,

We just completed the **Octave of Easter**, eight full days of celebrating the mystery of our Lord's death and Resurrection! Alleluia! We were led through the days of Lent with fasting, prayer and collecting alms for the poor. We prepared to renew our Baptismal promises, which we did, last Sunday at Easter Masses. Now, we look ahead to the 50 days of our Easter season, of which we are one week complete.

Today was designated **Divine Mercy Sunday** by Pope Saint John Paul II in 2000. He was passionate about the mission of revealing the mercy of Jesus to the world. At the canonization Mass for St. Faustina, he announced that the Second Sunday of Easter would be known as Divine Mercy Sunday. His purpose was to emphasize the meaning of the Resurrection and the depths of God's great mercy made available to all creation. Divine Mercy Sunday is not really a new feast day because the Second Sunday of Easter has always been a solemnity known as the Octave Day of Easter but we recognize that the richness of God's divine mercy comes to us not only through St. Faustina's particular revelations, but also through Scripture along with the history and tradition of our Church.

**Ordinations to the Priesthood** for the members of the Congregation of Holy Cross at Notre Dame took place on Saturday, April 15. Fr. Cameron traveled there to celebrate with the two young men ordained whom he knows. One day, one of them may come to serve us all here at Holy Redeemer parish. Also, the ordaining bishop was none other than the 10th Bishop of St. Cloud, Minnesota ... drum roll, please ...our own Bishop Patrick Neary.

Did you notice the new faces of **our young people**, most of them who are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation, who served as Ministers of Hospitality and Greeters during the Triduum and Easter Sunday Services? Let them know how much you appreciate their presence and their ministry.

**The Holy Redeemer School** Silent Auction begins online on Sunday, April 16 with the gala dinner and live auction on Saturday, April 22. Thanks to everyone who works to make this annual fundraiser such a wonderful event!

Next Sunday, **Emily Shelton will** enter into full communion with the Church at the 10 am Mass. Emily, already a baptized Christian, will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and Eucharist to become a full-fledged Roman Catholic. Thanks for your well wishes and prayers for her!

As we celebrate these 50 days of the Easter season, **THANK YOU** for your Baptism and the witness of your life as we live out our Baptismal promises. Alleluia!
