

# Fr. Paul's Message







Being adopted children of God means that we partake of the divine nature of sanctifying grace in Christ which causes us to enter into Trinitarian communion. We are heirs of glory, destined to see God as he is. If the world does not know us it is because it has not recognized Him. The world does not understand the demands of our being baptized, or accept them, because it neither knows nor loves Jesus Christ.

Therefore, we must be brave in the midst of the world to persevere in the life of grace and to bear witness to our faith in Jesus Christ even though we may be rejected and persecuted. I am the good shepherd, says Jesus. He is trying to make us understand the qualities of love he has for us. Jesus is the Good Shepherd who lays down his life for us because He loves us. He will not abandon us, or flee when we are in danger, when the enemy wants to destroy and separate us. He is always with us to defend us at the expense of his own life.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd who knows his sheep by love and they know him by the same love, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. The Father knows the Son and the Son knows the Father in the Holy Spirit. In that mystery of mutual love of knowledge in the Holy Spirit is the communion that Christ has for us and which we have for Him if we know Christ. We must persevere in the life of grace to experience the joy of love we have through and for Him.

I have other sheep not of this fold and need to bring to salvation He says. They hear my voice and there shall be one flock and one shepherd. Redemption is given for all, all that seek Jesus and the Church's mission. Jesus is the beloved of the Father for all eternity. He freely gave his life to save us. This is the command I received from the Father, Jesus tells us, and we who agree to it must love as He did, freely, fully, a complete gift of self for the salvation of another.

Today we celebrate the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. We ask you Lord Jesus for vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life. May there be young people willing to say yes to Christ in love for knowledge and love of Christ to reach all.
