She said, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters."

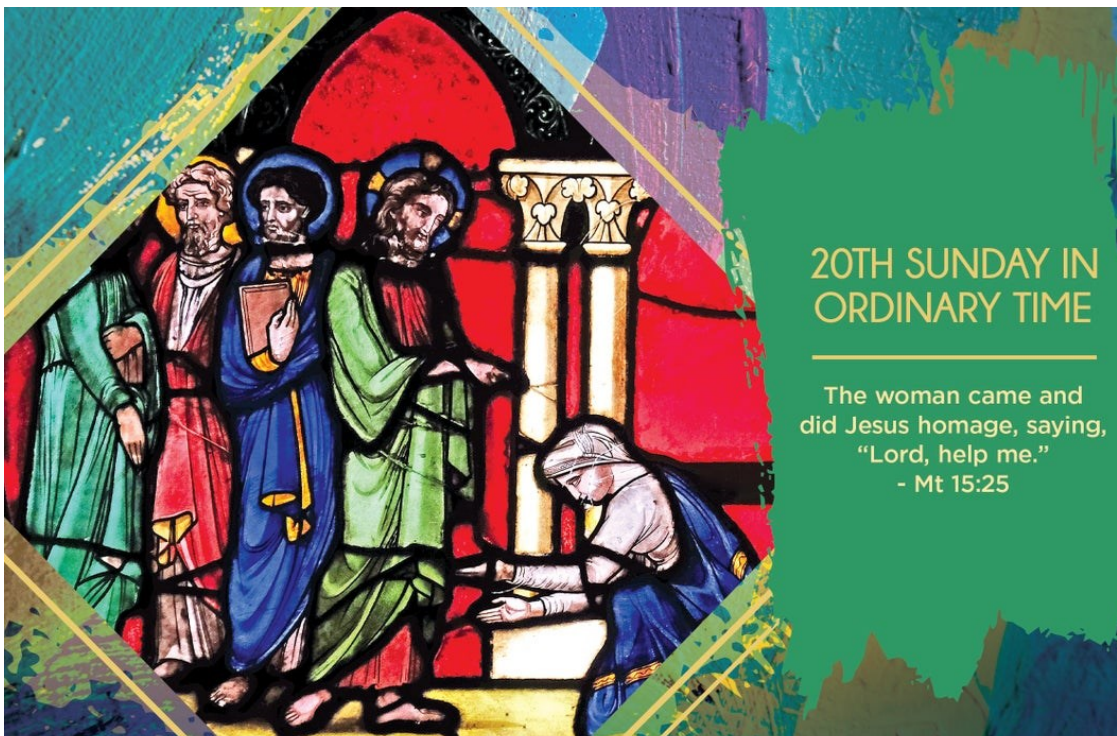
And I heard Janis, desperate, pleading for love. And in some ways, Christ crucified, rejected, and yet ever pleading for love of us.
