### HOLY REDEEMER'S SVDP CONFERENCE

"Giving help and hope one person at a time." The Society of St. Vincent de Paul was founded by a small group of students in Paris in 1835 and now stretches across the globe. Its namesake and patron saint was a sixteenth century priest from Pouy, France who became known as the "Father of the Poor." The Society was unique for its time in that it was formed by lay Catholics, and it offered charity to foreigners as well as non-Catholics. A truly Christian enterprise! Our

conference at Holy Redeemer seeks to reflect this Vincentian spirit through our rent and utility assistance program as well as a food pantry, all staffed and funded entirely through volunteers. Our pantry receives food from the parish as well as partner agencies such as the Oregon Food Bank, Safeway, and Nite Hawk Cafe & Lounge. Each conference is governed by a Board of Directors which includes a spiritual advisor and is overseen by the Portland District Council www.svdppdx.org. #### **CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION**



# Fr. Pat's Message



Dear Friends:

By now you are aware that we have a Care for Creation Circle at Holy Redeemer Parish. While it is a fairly new group, I am confident that it will soon begin growing. I'm grateful to the people of the Madeleine Parish that

have mentored members of our Circle. Its whole purpose is to help us understand how we can be better stewards of the good earth God has entrusted to us, which Pope Francis calls *our common home*.

In the view of Pope Francis, the misuse and abuse of our environment begins with distorted human thinking that treats the world as a thing to be used and exploited. In his own words, "If someone has not learned to stop and admire something beautiful, we should not be surprised if he or she treats everything as an object to be used and abused without scruple. If we want to bring about deep change, we need to realize that certain mindsets really do influence our behavior. Our efforts at education will be inadequate and ineffective unless we strive to promote a new way of thinking about human beings, life, society and our relationship with nature. Otherwise, the paradigm of consumerism will continue to advance, with the help of the media and the highly effective workings of the market."

He also suggests that we should see the earth like we would a very poor person. He writes that, "the earth herself, burdened and laid waste, is among the most abandoned and maltreated of our poor; she 'groans in travail' (Rom 8:22). We have forgotten that we ourselves are dust of the earth (cf. Gen 2:7); our very bodies are made up of her elements, we breathe her air and we receive life and refreshment from her waters."

As we grow in our understanding of the change of mindset needed to help turn around the deteriorating condition of our earth, it is also important that we, as a Holy Redeemer community, begin to clean up our own parish grounds and our nearby neighborhood together.

Therefore, I am pleased to invite you to join the Holy Redeemer Care for Creation Circle in its first SOLVE clean-up event on **Saturday August 27**<sup>th</sup>. The event will be from **9am-Noon**, though folks can leave early if needed.
