## Fr. Paul's Message



Dear Holy Redeemer,



Certain things cause me to well up with emotion, a saying, a scene in a movie, a memory of a loved one. I believe all these things can push us along the Way of God, toward that Great God of Salvation.

I was again watching *The Lord of the Rings* for the umpteenth time and one scene always causes me to break. It's Samwise Gamgee looking down on a broken helpless Frodo Baggins, their journey nearly complete and their bodies totally spent, the weight of the "ring" causing Frodo to lose all hope. Samwise says "Come, Mr. Frodo! I can't carry it for you, but I can carry you."

On September 11, 2001, Todd Beamer, a passenger on Flight 93, tried to place a call through an air phone, but he was routed to a customer service representative instead, who passed him on to a supervisor, Lisa Jefferson. The passengers were planning to attack the hijackers and regain control of the aircraft, after they learned about what happened at the World Trade Center and The Pentagon. Beamer recited the Lord's Prayer and the 23rd Psalm with Jefferson, prompting others to join in. Beamer requested of Jefferson, "If I don't make it, please call my family and let them know how much I love them"; After this, Jefferson heard muffled voices and Beamer clearly answering, "Are you ready? Okay. Let's roll."

I personally have been reminiscing with my sisters on the anniversaries of our parents' deaths, stories and pictures, pieces of clothing and art, little sayings and mannerisms. All these things cause me to well up inside, my father's smile/smirk of approval, my mother saying "I. See. You!"

"This is the time of fulfillment." How might we hear that? With joy? With sorrow? With fear or apprehension? All that we have experienced has brought us to this moment and finally in the Christ, it is time. The time to fulfill the covenant. The time to call forth the disciples. The time to no longer fish for our livelihood, but call forth all toward salvation, to become fishers of men.
