

and Nite Hawk Cafe & Lounge. Learn more at www.svdppdx.org.




JVENCORPS A PROGRAM OF JVC NORTHWEST

Fr. Paul's Message



Dear Holy Redeemer,

Our readings this week reminded me of *The Little Prince* by Antoine de Saint-Exupéry. Especially the Little Prince's encounter with the Fox. The Greek translation for the word "**meek**" found in this week's Gospel is much akin to our word "**tame**."

"My life is very monotonous," the fox said. "I hunt chickens; men hunt me. All the chickens are just alike, and all the men are just alike. And, in consequence, I am a little bored. But if you **tame** me, it will be as if the sun came to shine on my life. I shall know the sound of a step that will be different from all the others. Other steps send me hurrying back underneath the ground. Yours will call me, like music, out of my burrow. And then look: you see the grain-fields down yonder? I do not eat bread. Wheat is of no use to me. The wheat fields have nothing to say to me. And that is sad. But you have hair that is the color of gold. Think how wonderful that will be when you have tamed me! The grain, which is also golden, will bring me back the thought of you. And I shall love to listen to the wind in the wheat . . ."

"One only understands the things that one **tames**," said the fox. "Men have no more time to understand anything. They buy things already made at the shops. But there is no shop anywhere where one can buy friendship, and so men have no friends any more. If you want a friend, **tame** me .."

The Little Prince goes about **taming** the Fox by doing two simple things, he abides by a ritual, going each day at the same time so as to make the time spent with the Fox unlike any other time, one that they both remember is special, dedicated to one another. And secondly the Little Prince becomes responsible for the Fox. His Fox is like no other, he has spent time with this particular Fox, he has given of his very self in time and in care of the Fox. The Fox is his friend and unlike other foxes this particular Fox is worth risking everything for.

The Fox then shares a secret with the Little Prince: "It is only with the heart that one can see rightly; what is essential is invisible to the eye... Men have forgotten this truth," said the fox. "But you must not forget it. You become responsible, forever, for what you have **tamed**."

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am **meek** and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." – Jesus Christ, Gospel of Matthew

"The world offers you comfort. But you were not made for comfort. You were made for greatness." - *Pope Benedict XVI*

May you be **tamed**, each Sunday, at a special place and time, Holy Redeemer at Mass, that God keep you and bless you always, for you belong to Him and He to you, all through Christ our Lord. Amen.
