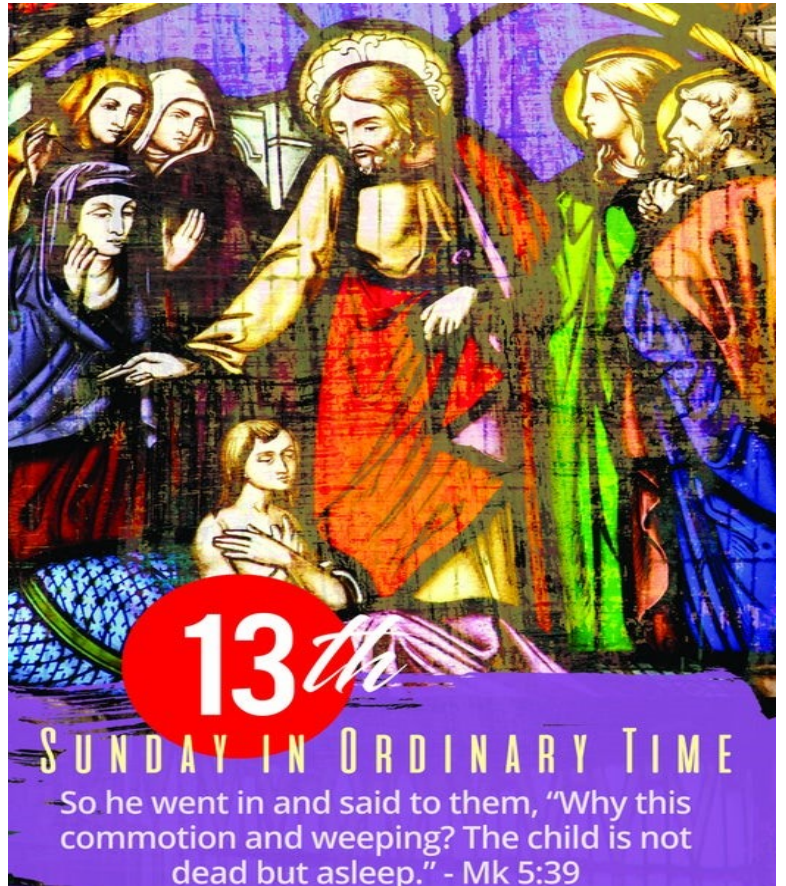

## Pastor's Message

Dear good people of Holy Redeemer -

### Where was Fr. Pat?

By the time this bulletin column is printed, Fr. Pat will have returned from his two weeks away. Did you notice that he was gone? Every six years, about 50 priests and brothers of the Congregation of Holy Cross meet in order to (1) discern the direction of our USA Province within our ministries - parishes, school, overseas foundations - as well as to (2) oversee recommendations of how we, as men who embrace the religious vows of chastity, poverty and obedience live out our lives together. This year, the Chapter convened at Kings' College in Wilkes-Barre, PA, one of our Holy Cross founded and staffed institutions.

Fr. Pat was elected as one of the delegates and spent a good amount of time prior to the Chapter as a chair for one of the subcommittees. He met with the other CSCs via Zoom and continued to chair that group once they gathered in Pennsylvania for the Chapter. At a Chapter, there's a lot of camaraderie but also a lot of work to do: reading documents, hearing the ideas of others from different continents, and trying to live out our religious life more fully within the current world situation. Thanks for keeping him in prayer since he is really committed to the Congregation and to his ministry as pastor here. It's just that we need to share him with others from time to time.

### June 27, the Memorial of Our Mother of Perpetual Help

On Tuesday mornings, following the 7:15 am Mass, we offer a series of prayers through the intercession of Mary under the title of Our Mother of Perpetual Help. Her image, enshrined in our sanctuary, is part of the history of this parish and the legacy of the Redemptorists who founded and staffed Holy Redeemer for so many years. Our icon is a copy of the original that is traced back to 1495. Although the original icon was forgotten in a Roman church for nearly 300 years and almost destroyed by Napoleon Bonaparte, Pope Pius IX entrusted this icon to the Redemptorist Congregation in 1886 and they helped to spread this devotion to Mary throughout the world. We can pray to Christ through Mary and ask her prayers especially for families, for mothers and children. **Our Mother of Perpetual Help, pray for us!**

### First Communion en español

Next Sunday, July 4, we will celebrate the First Communion Mass at noon for our Spanish-speaking children and young people. Carmen Salvador and many other catechists and volunteers have worked among them for the past several weeks. These young people, their parents and even some of their godparents have faithfully come to Holy Redeemer for instruction classes, prayer and retreat in order to help their children who are ready to receive this Sacrament. They, as parents and godparents, have committed themselves to learn more about their Catholic faith as they walk ever closer with Jesus Christ, our Holy Redeemer.
