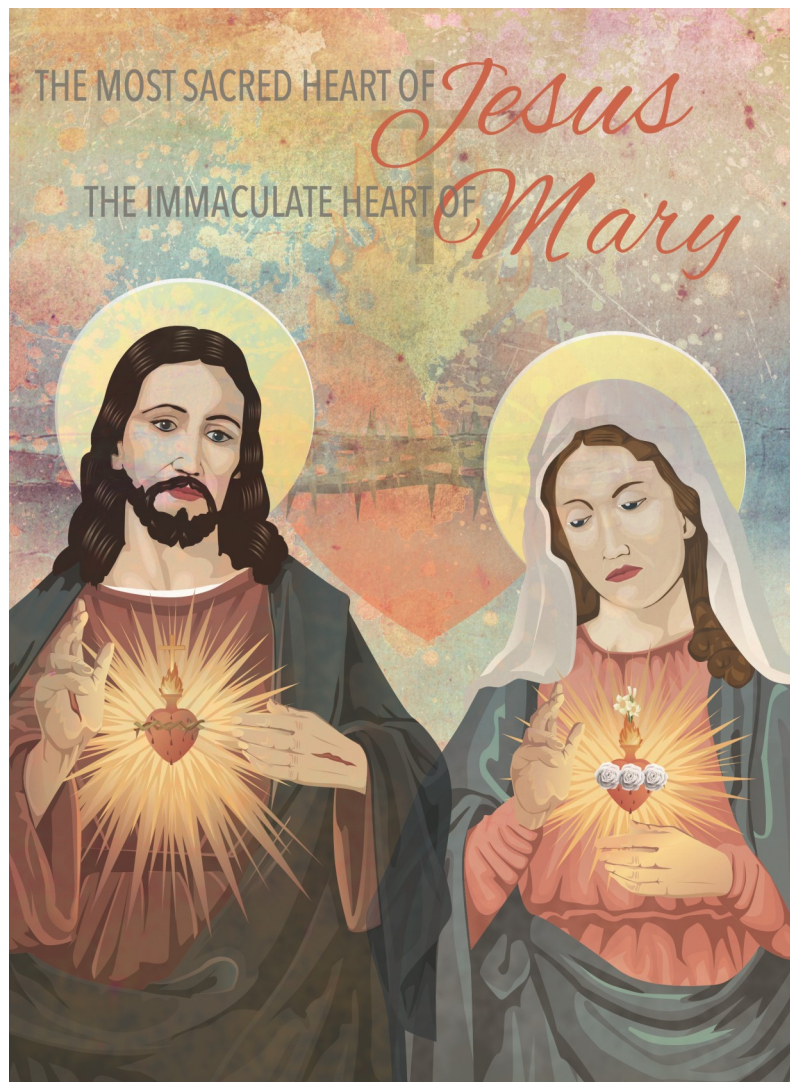

## Pastor's Message

Dear Friends:

I continue to be amazed by how quickly time passes. Three years ago, in June of 2018, I attended our Provincial Chapter at King's College (one of our Holy Cross colleges) in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, before coming here to Holy Redeemer. It was providential that Fr. John Dougherty was also a delegate to that Provincial Chapter. He was so very helpful in walking me through the ins and outs of being Pastor at Holy Redeemer.

Now I find myself heading once again to our Provincial Chapter at King's College. I will be away from June 9-24, which feels like a long time to me! For those of you not familiar with religious orders in the Catholic Church, every few years we have provincial chapters to reflect together on the key issues that define our life and mission together. At our Provincial Chapter, we look at our life in community, vocations and recruitment, the quality of our seminary formation, the status of our universities and parishes, province finances, and our support of our Districts of Chile, Peru, and East Africa.

The highest authority in a religious order is the legislation that emerges from our collective discernment at our provincial chapters, which helps guide our elected leadership for the next three years in shepherding the more than 446 Holy Cross men who belong to the United States Province of Priests and Brothers.

While the time there is busy, it also feels like a family reunion. So many of the delegates to the Provincial Chapter were men who were in charge of my seminary formation, or guys that I had in the seminary when I was rector at Moreau Seminary at Notre Dame. Many of my seminary friends and classmates are there, as well as the younger Holy Cross men who represent the future. I feel that these men are truly brothers and family to me, and I feel a love and affection that truly sustains and inspires me.

I leave you in capable hands with Fr. Michael at the helm in my absence. Aaron Morris, C.S.C., a Holy Cross seminarian in temporary vows, will be with us until August 7, and Cameron Cortens, C.S.C., our future deacon, will arrive on July 19. Cameron will make his perpetual profession of vows at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart at Notre Dame on Saturday, August 28, and be ordained a transitional deacon on Sunday, August 29, at Moreau Seminary.

Please pray for the 55 delegates who will be part of our Provincial Chapter, that we can truly be open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. In addition, thank you for your daily prayers for me and for Fr. Michael, who are so privileged to serve you at Holy Redeemer. Lastly, please pray for the good young men in formation to become Holy Cross priests and brothers. Aaron Morris and Cameron Cortens remind me why I feel so optimistic about our future.

May all of you have a much-deserved vacation this summer after these many months of pandemic. May God continue to bless you and your families with every grace and blessing.
