

Every year, Holy Cross' Office of Vocations hosts the two-week Summer Seminary Immersion Program (SSIP) for rising high school junior and senior men at Moreau Seminary on the campus of the University of Notre Dame. Co-hosted by Notre Dame's Summer Scholars, the program includes a course on the priesthood, the consecrated life, and the Catholic tradition, as well as daily Mass, Liturgy of the Hours, Eucharistic Adoration, service work, fellowship, and much more. A college credit is offered through Notre Dame for this course.



Fr. Cameron's Message



Dear Holy Redeemer Family,

This Sunday, our Church celebrates the Feast of Pentecost. The themes of language and communication are conspicuous in the Scripture readings that mark the liturgies this day.

The Spirit first manifests in the upper room as a sound—that of a mighty wind—and then as tongues of fire appearing over the Apostles. When they go out to proclaim the Gospel to a mixed crowd of pilgrims and travelers from different nations, all are astounded that they can understand the preaching of this group of Galilean misfits in their own native tongue. St. Paul teaches that it is only in the Spirit that our lips can profess in faith, "Jesus is Lord!"

The same Spirit that descended on Pentecost dwells in the Church today, and lives in you and me. Though most of us are probably not blessed with the gift of speaking in foreign tongues—our life in the Spirit will very much involve language and communication. We are called to communicate God's truth and love through our works and through our words each day, to help unite what is divided and bring clarity and understanding where there is confusion. Filled with the Spirit, we become the instruments by which God's language—Indeed, His very Word made flesh—may be encountered, heard, and understood by all.

In this past week, I've been blessed to witness God's Spirit at work in many ways in our community; allow me to highlight two.

On Saturday, May 20th, Our Holy Redeemer 'Care for Creation Circle' gathered a group to join at least three other parishes in our NE Portland Vicariate (St. Andrew's, the Madeleine, and St. Charles) on a "Climate Justice Prayer Walk" inspired by Pope Francis's call in *Laudato Si* to unite in fomenting social change to better care for our common home, the event began at K^hunamokwst Park, which was the first of four stations visited. Each station focused on a different group or part of creation that are impacted by human-caused pollution and climate change. Indigenous Peoples, diverse species of wildlife, young people, and refugees who are forced to leave their homes for climate-related reasons were all highlighted at the different stations, as personal stories were joined to moments of prayer. The work of improving our stewardship of our shared planet and its resources is certainly an effort for which the Spirit seeks to call us together in our time.

Second, on Tuesday, May 23rd, the Holy Spirit (along with an abundance of school spirit) was alive and active in the Holy Redeemer 7th and 8th grade classes as they put on a joint basketball game to fundraise for another Holy Cross-run school that was just newly established in Rajshahi, Bangladesh. Holy Cross School and College is a K-12 school has been founded to serve a mostly poor and ethnic indigenous population of the region. The basketball fundraiser will be just the beginning of an on-going relationship of communication and friendship between the two schools in the coming years.

Finally, I'll end with an invitation to all parishioners to attend two school-related events next weekend:

- The Holy Redeemer Spotlight Concert on June 3, 6:00-8:30 pm in Cantwell Hall. The event involves a social hour with food and drink, followed by a show with alumnus Chris Koza performing with the current HR Youth Choir. Also, I have the great honor of playing as the opening act, accompanied by my sister Teresa White, and John Mannenbach on guitar!
