HOLY REDEEMER SVDP CONFERENCE

For the week of October 21st we have served 26 families with \$2,879 in food & utility/rent assistance. Holy Redeemer church/school donated 260 lbs of food and volunteers offered 43 hours of time. Thank you for your ongoing love and sacrifice.

NEED EMERGENCY FOOD ASSISTANCE?

HR's SVDP Food Room (back side of church, basement level) is open every Wednesday and Saturday, 2:30 - 4:00 PM. Anyone in need of emergency food is encouraged to go to the food room during these hours of operation to be given emergency food. All requests are treated confidentially.

RENT & UTILITY ASSISTANCE

We currently are able to provide more emergency rent and utility assistance to persons who are facing utility cutoff or eviction. Assistance is provided to persons/households within our parish boundaries (N. Alberta to the Columbia River and N. Denver to NE 26th Ave.) We are able to provide this assistance thanks to the generosity of parishioners, and recently with additional funds from a grant from the Oregon Community Foundation.



Pastor's Message



Dear Friends:

If there is one constant about this pandemic, it is that there is a need for constant adaptation and change. Certainly our parish routine has been greatly altered, far beyond anything we ever could have imagined. Since reopening the church for liturgies in mid-May, our first concern has been to abide by approved health protocols. To date, I believe that the measures in place have proven quite effective.

With that in mind, we feel that we are now in a position to have Thursday Eucharistic Adoration and Saturday confessions, albeit with a few modifications.

Thursday Eucharistic Adoration. Eucharistic Adoration is now being offered on **Thursdays from 4:30–7:30 p.m.** in the church. An usher will be present to sign in anyone who wishes to attend and will also assign seating in a designated pew. There is no need to pre-register. Anyone attending must wear a mask. Pews will be sanitized when vacated.

Saturday Confessions. Confessions will be available in the church on **Saturday mornings from 10:00-11:00 a.m., beginning on Saturday, November 7.** An usher will sign in those who wish to receive the sacrament and will also assign seating in a designated pew. There is no need to pre-register. Anyone attending must wear a mask. A high grade air purifier has been placed in the confessional that removes 99.97% of airborne germs and viruses. After each confession, surfaces in the confessional will be sanitized by the priest on duty. Pews will be sanitized when vacated.

Fr. Michael and I will continue to be available for confessions by appointment, as well, by simply calling the parish office at 503-285-4539.

St. Vincent de Paul needs foodstuffs! As you may be aware, food banks across the country are facing food shortages for a number of reasons. Our own St. Vincent de Paul Conference at Holy Redeemer is facing a shortage of meat, eggs, fresh fruit, canned vegetables, cereal, jelly, and other canned meals. If you can, please bring needed food items to the St. Vincent de Paul office on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 2:30-4:00 p.m., or to the Rectory Office Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Your generosity to increasing numbers of families who find themselves in need is greatly appreciated.

May God shed light, wisdom, and peace upon our land as we prepare for national elections on November 3, and continue to bless those most affected by this pandemic.
