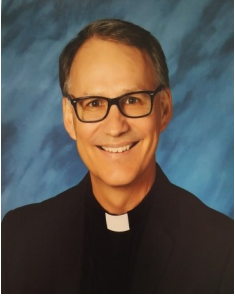

## Pastor's Message



Dear Friends:

There has been a lot going on at Holy Redeemer the past few weeks. And it seems to me that a lot of thanks are in order.

### **Weekend of Prayer and Vigilance, October 8-11**

It has been said that God brings grace out of even the worst of things. While we were very upset by the offensive graffiti spray painted on our church doors back in July, and the F.B.I. asked us to be vigilant against a reprisal event last weekend leading up to Columbus Day, our response as a parish proved to be a wonderful experience. For four consecutive nights we had Eucharistic Adoration from 8 p.m. until 1 a.m. to pray for victims of injustice and those who inflict injustices, and from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. we had teams of volunteer sentinels who would take turns walking around the church block.

The greatest grace was that it was just fun to be together! A number of parishioners met each other for the first time. Over coffee, tea, and snacks, we truly felt united and blessed to have spent time together in the quiet hours of the night and the morning. One parishioner remarked that it was the best experience of community he had ever had at Holy Redeemer.

I want to thank Kathy Battilega and Carmen Salvador in a special way for organizing the sign-ups for all involved. I am also grateful to Fr. Michael for leading the start of Eucharistic Adoration each night. And thanks to everyone who came to pray or to be on duty as sentinels to assure the safety of our parish property. This event will go down in the parish history books.

### **Holy Redeemer School Jogathon, October 15**

Our annual Holy Redeemer School Jogathon took place on Friday, October 15. As of the writing of this column, we were nearing the finish line of our \$35,000 goal. I want to thank Laura Elias and Theresa Berney for their outstanding leadership in organizing this event.
